The NDO process

- Mentors are assigned
- *Session 1:* Mentee attends one of the Mentor's classes before **10 February**
- *Session 2:* Mentor attends one of the Mentee's classes and provide constructive feedback before **24 February**
- *Session 3:* Mentor attends one of the Mentee's classes for a second time and provide constructive feedback before **31 March**
- *Session 4:* First formal evaluation is done before **12 May**
- *Session 5:* Second formal evaluation is done before **13 October**
